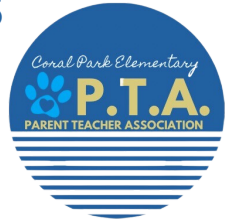

President - Responsible for running and managing all aspects of the PTA and holding meetings.

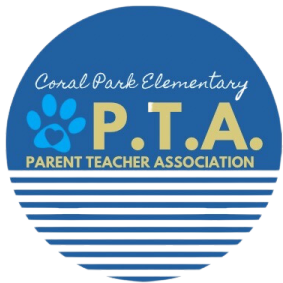
VP of Fundraising - Plans fundraiser events and raising money for the PTA.

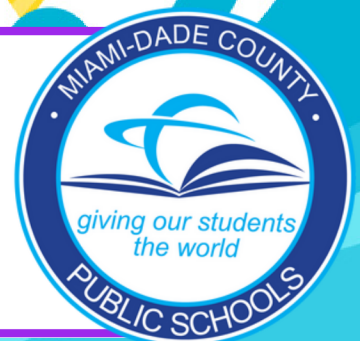

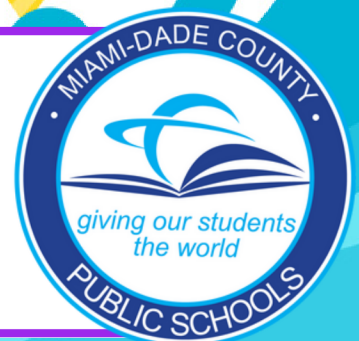

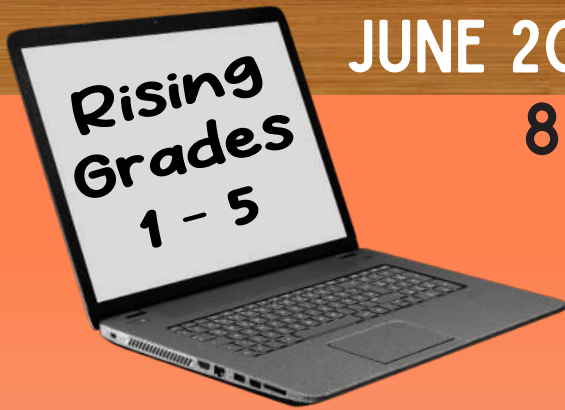
