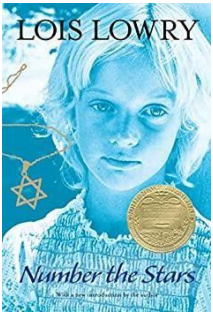

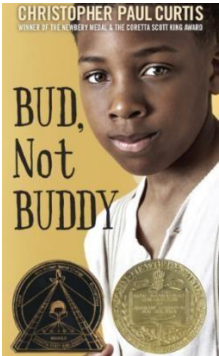
Reading class requires two novels to read throughout the year. The others, we will provide. Please see that your child has a copy of each.
