

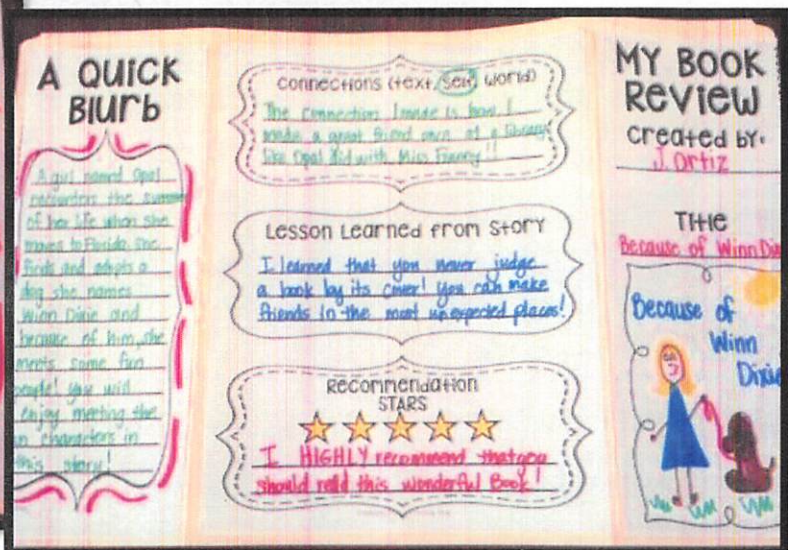
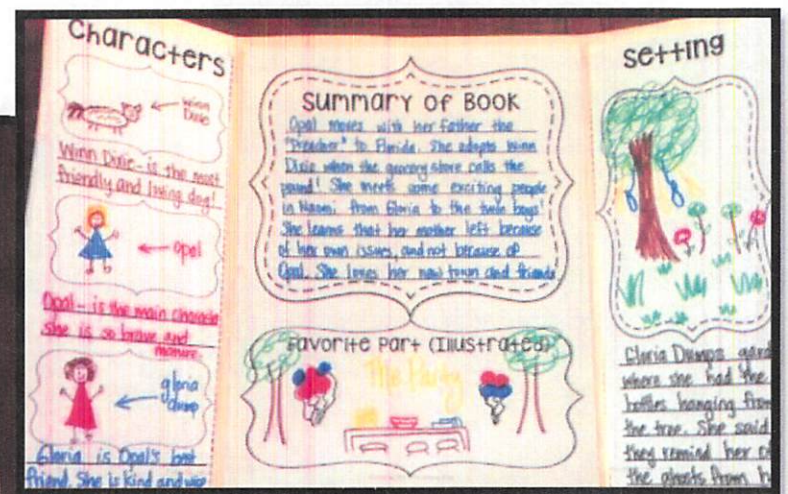
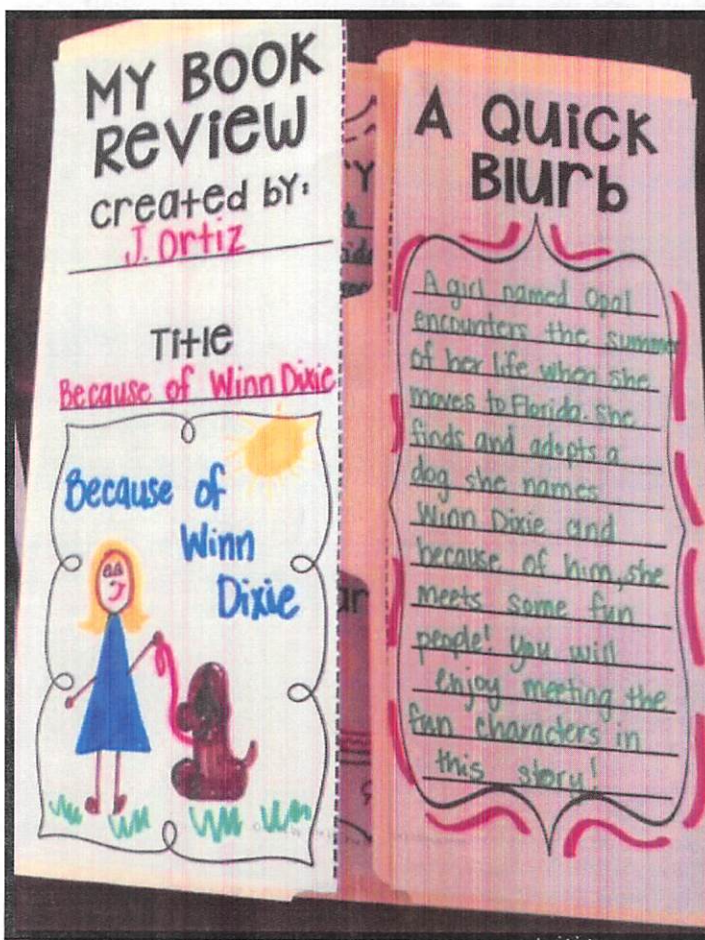
Teacher Tips

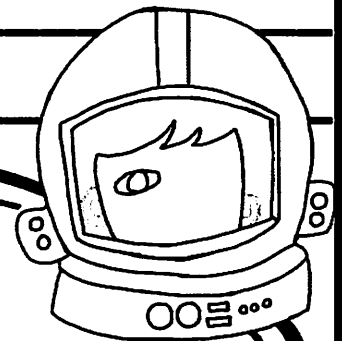

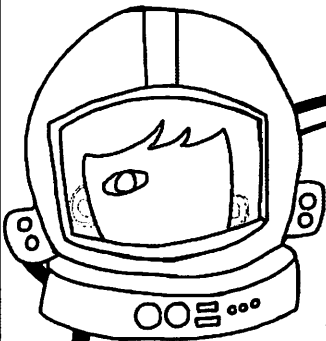
